



# NSU Center for Statewide E-learning 2018-19 High School Registration Information and Course List

**District registration opens at 9 a.m. Monday, March 26, and runs to 5 p.m. Friday, March 30, 2018.** All districts registering any time during this period will be accepted into courses or put on waiting lists based on their DOE sparsity rankings.

**District registration re-opens at 9 a.m. Monday, April 9, 2018.** At this time, we will continue to accept additional districts into the program on a first-come, first-served basis until courses are full.

**Classes begin August 21, 2018, and end May 17, 2019.** All courses are tuition-free to school districts.

## Three Methods of Delivery

- 1) DDN:** DDN classes meet five days a week via DDN. A DDN course meets at a predetermined time with direct engagement between the teacher and the students on a daily basis. These synchronous classes typically connect students from several schools.
- 2) Blended:** A blended course features the convenience of an online course and the engagement of a DDN course. Schools schedule the course at a time that fits the school's local schedule. The DDN connections are between the teacher and the school, on the school's local schedule. Schools with a low number of students in a blended class may need to consolidate sessions depending on staffing availability.
- 3) Online:** An online course features the convenience of allowing a student to interact with the course work at a time determined by the student and the local school. Students view recorded class sessions, interacting with the content asynchronously. All class sessions and materials are available online. The course follows a traditional school calendar.

## Changes for 2018-19
