

# **DR. RUSSELL BROCK MEMORIAL** **SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

In order to encourage and recognize superior student writing at Northern State University, the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences offers an annual award for the best student paper.

Two monetary awards will be given, one for the best paper of a technical nature (science, business, etc.) and one for the best paper of a non-technical nature (history, philosophy, literary criticism, etc.).

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Any undergraduate student enrolled at Northern may enter a paper.

Papers must be written in connection with a course in Arts and Sciences, and the course instructor must approve the submission of the paper.

Papers must be non-fiction, in English, typed double-spaced with the text a minimum of six to eight pages in length. Both technical and non-technical papers are accepted this year.

*Papers written after January 1 of the current academic year will be eligible for the award.*

Papers must be the original work of individual students, but they may be revised and improved by the student after grading by the course instructor.

## **PROCEDURE**

A student may ask his or her instructor to submit a paper for award consideration.

The course instructor will submit the paper to his or her department chair if he or she believes that the paper is worthy of consideration.

Each department chair may submit up to three student papers for award consideration to the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.

*The papers must be received in the Dean's office by Noon on April 4, 2019.*

The selection committee will consist of the Dean and the Department Chairs of the College of Arts and Sciences.
