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## Subjects Taught

### ***Transmedia Storytelling (PUBR2000) at Curtin University, Malaysia.***

The course highlights the need to incorporate both traditional and new media as a means to create a holistic public relations approach. Students were taught the appropriate methods and skills to develop transmedia storytelling campaigns through the use of the latest media platforms such as Canva, Plytoon, etc. Case studies were also presented to further enhance students understanding of the concept of transmedia.

### ***Asian Politics (COM654) at Universiti Teknologi MARA***

This is one of the core subjects for students enrolled in the Mass Communication undergraduate program at Universiti Teknologi MARA. This course provides the students with contemporary issues in media and politics in the Asia region, with specific emphasis on ASEAN.

### ***Media Law, Regulation & Ethics (COM540) at Universiti Teknologi MARA***

This course intends to expose and help students to understand various types of law that can be imposed on media practitioners in the Malaysian setting. Special highlights focus on major events in Malaysia that had influenced the current political and legal framework in the country such as the infamous Racial Riots of 1969, Operasi Lalang, Student Movement among others.

### ***Psychology (LIB410) at Universiti Teknologi MARA***

This undergraduate course offers an overview of psychology and its relevance to media studies. Students are exposed to the theories and practice of psychology as viewed by contemporary psychologists. A background introduction to major media-related psychological theories is also introduced in this course.

### ***Corporate Public Relations (PRO541) at Universiti Teknologi MARA***

This course is to equip students with knowledge and understanding in corporate public relations practice. It gives the students the ability to apply public relations strategies and techniques in management.

### ***Theories of Media, Information Warfare, and Perception Management (MIC702) at the Centre of Media & Information Warfare Studies (CMIWS) Universiti Teknologi MARA***

One of the core subjects for post-graduate students enrolled in the Master in Media & Information Studies. This course highlights the role of major theories in media studies, propaganda literature, as well as perception management techniques.

### ***Media and Malaysian Society (COM510) at Universiti Teknologi MARA***

This course focuses on the roles, functions, and effects of mass media towards Malaysian society. Various topics related to mass media and Malaysian society will be discussed throughout the studies. Among the issues are media and ideology, the economics of mass media and media effects theory. The topics will delve into the global mass media issue that has been shown worldwide and has an impact on society, either positive or negative. As the media has become globalized, there are a lot of challenges faced by Malaysian society. This study will enhance the students' knowledge about mass media and the reality in Malaysian society.

### ***Communication Theory (COM530) at Universiti Teknologi MARA***

This course aims to introduce students to the functions, value, and relevance of theories in the study of communication. Topics presented are the fundamental theories advanced in the evolution of communication discipline and those that have shaped the character of the field. It helps students to understand the pervasiveness of theories in communication, diversity of approaches, concerns, and assumptions developed by communication theorists. This course also attempts to develop a good understanding and appreciation of the complex, multifaceted process of communication and how these communication theories can be applied in various communication perspectives.
